Beauty treatments such as Nanobubble Ozone Shampoo & Cut Course, Total Skin Care

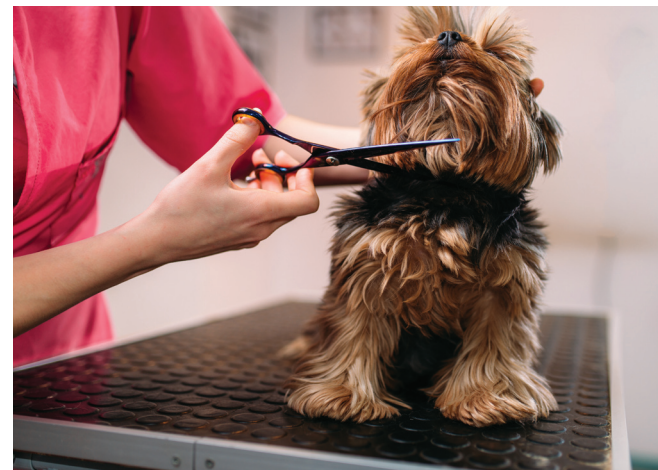

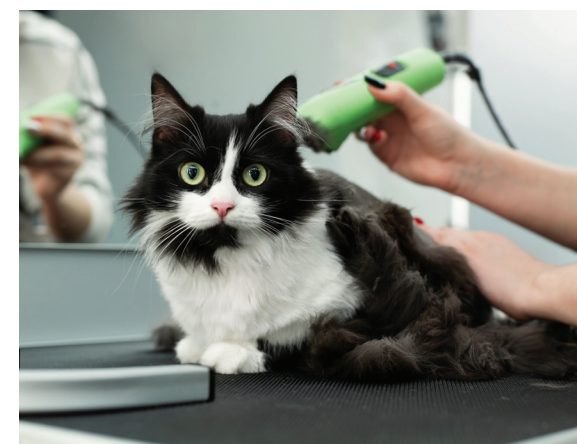

Whiskers n Paws

The team at Whiskers n Paws view grooming as something more essential than just a method of beautification. They emphasise the good hygiene that comes with having a clean pet because it ultimately ensures that the home is sanitary, too.

Pet owners can choose between the mini-groom or the full groom, and sessions at their Ap Lei Chau headquarters can range from 90 minutes to four hours depending on the animal's size, age and whether it happens to be the pet's first time to be groomed. Nervous parents are welcome to watch the entire process, but that is completely unnecessary – unless it is to snap photos or see your pet enjoy an environment where calmness pervades. A retail shop, patio and café will help pass the time if you do stay on site.

Committed to caring and doing a diligent job, the pet beauty salon only takes a few clients each day, so it is advisable to book an appointment a week in advance. It opens from 10 am to 6 pm from Monday to Friday, closing an hour later at weekends and public holidays.
